

Hillsborough County Transportation Vulnerability Assessment Pilot Project Stakeholder Meetings – SAVE THE DATE-UPDATES

The Hillsborough County MPO, Planning Commission, Hillsborough County Public Works-Hazard Mitigation Section, the University of South Florida, and the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Commission received a grant from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to conduct a pilot project to assess the resiliency of the transportation system in Hillsborough County. Federal, State DOT, and local resiliency planning information will be used to assess the transportation network’s vulnerability to sea level rise, storm surge, and flooding. Specifically; this project will facilitate the identification of adaptation strategies for incorporation into the MPO’s 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan, currently being updated.
