The assumptions, stereotypes, and unintentional actions (positive or negative) we make towards others based on identity labels like race, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, or ability. Because our implicit associations are stored in our subconscious, we may act on our biases without even realizing it. Often, our implicit biases contradict our values. This special two hour training is designed to expose our unconscious biases, provide tools to adjust these automatic thinking patterns, and eliminate discriminatory behaviors.

Mr. Jeffery Lorick is a seasoned executive with over 10 years of investigative and compliance experience. After joining the Pinellas County Human Rights Office as an investigator in 2016, he accepted the position of Compliance Manager in October 2018. An expert in anti-harassment, diversity, and implicit bias training, Mr. Lorick is currently providing training to all Pinellas County employees, including managers and supervisors. He also manages the day-to-day operations of the Pinellas County Office of Human Rights and investigates employment, housing, and public accommodation allegations of discrimination. Mr. Lorick sits on the Board of Directors of the National Association of Human Rights Workers, the International Association of Official Human Rights Agencies, and is a lifetime member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

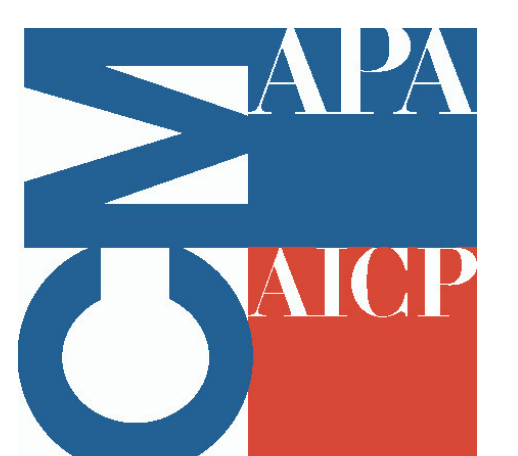
