13	Slowing down speeds on our local roads was one of the major Vision Zero strategies that Leah Shahum of the Vision Zero Network drove home during her keynote presentation at the #GCSafeStreetsSummit on Tuesday. Data shows that only 1/10 pedestrians survive collisions at 40mph and 5/10 pedestrians survive collisions at 30mph, but 9/10 pedestrians survive collisions at 20mph. According to the VisionZeroNetwork.org website: "Speed is a factor in nearly one-third of all traffic deaths in the United States. From 2010 to 2015, 59,374 American lives were lost in crashes related to excessive speed. They all left behind children and loved ones, such as mother Valerie Jones, whose 17-year-old daughter Alexis Miranda was struck and killed on her way to class at Chamberlain High School on October 6th, 2015. 25	Should planners have built a massive 8-lane pedestrian bridge in the first place? "That's what one local urban planning studio is asking. Last week, street planners Victor Dover and Kenneth García of the Miami firm Dover, Kohl & Partners published a proposal for redesigning the area. The pair criticized not only the 'accelerated bridge construction' technique used in the FIU-Sweetwater UniversityCity Bridge, but the fundamental design of the street it once spanned: It's clear that among official priorities, traffic flow eclipsed public safety long ago on Eighth Street. The corridor metastasized into a monster highway with eight, nine, ten lanes and no meaningful provision for walking, biking or transit, or even trees, despite its gigantic 130-foot right-of-way. We are correctly focused right now on the six victims killed under the bridge collapse. "We had 16 people lose their lives on the roads in District 7 this week. Of these 16 fatalities, 9 were vulnerable users (5 motorcycle, 1 bicycle and 3 pedestrians). At our Tampa Operations quarterly meeting this week, our maintenance staff reported that they had responded to six fatal crash locations in the past week, which as you know can be a hard situation to respond to, especially almost on a daily basis." Several of these deaths involved distracted driving, including a case of texting while driving. But was the motorist speeding? Were they driving aggressively? Or looking at their phone? In Jeff Germain-Roger's case there are no crossings on Sligh Avenue between N. Boulevard and Rome... a distance of ½ mile. Who would walk a half mile and back to cross a roadway when they see their destination across the street?
